To keep you up-to-date on our efforts to keep our residents and staff safe, we will send out updates as things change in our community:

- **Our COVID-19 situational update:** As of 6/11/20, we have 0 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our care center.
- **Our supply of protective equipment:** Our current supply of PPE (personal protective equipment) is sufficient.
- **Employee Screening:** All JMHS employees are screened each shift before working with residents. They are asked screening questions and have their temperature taken before every shift.
- **Resident/Tenant Screening:** All residents and tenants are screened daily, with screening questions and temperatures taken.
- **Outdoor Visits:** We apologize that Outdoor Visits have been put on hold. The Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) continues to work with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to determine guidance for all long-term care organizations. We are optimistic to hear further guidance within the upcoming weeks.
- **Window Visits:** We did receive further guidance from the Department of Health on Window Visits. Here are the guidelines from MDH:
 - The visitor should notify staff as to when the window visit will occur.
 - The visitor and resident must wear a cloth mask (unless medically contraindicated).
 - There must be six feet of distance between the resident and visitor.
 - The window can be open a reasonable amount to have a conversation.

Starting Tuesday, June 16, JMHS Care Center will host a weekly Zoom Meeting to provide updates for families. We will also allow for some questions and answers.

The Zoom Meeting will begin promptly at 4pm and conclude at 4:30pm, CST. If we are not able to take all questions during this time, we are happy to schedule a call or receive emails to provide answers.

We ask that you do not ask specific questions related to your resident/tenant, so we are able to maintain and respect privacy. These specific questions should be communicated directly with Amanda Redepenning, Care Center Director of Nursing, or Stacey Lee, Licensed Nursing Home Administrator.
